UNDERSTAND AND EXPLAIN VARIOUS FEATURES OF PREZI SCREENCASTS

- Application of cloud-based media: text, audio, video, graphics, and photos for building screencasts.
- Application of Prezi for use on multiple display formats: smart phones, laptops, desktops, iPads, and other portable devices
- Application of embedded media within Prezi – Google images, MP3 audio and YouTube video
- Application of the Prezi composition canvas for developing a variety of “wayfaring” navigational paths through course content.
- Application of Prezi for interactive brainstorming and creating “mental maps”
- Application of Prezi for collaborative team projects and distributed synchronized online teaching
- Application of Prezi as a presentation tool for student projects.

DEMONSTRATE FUNDAMENTAL PREZI SCREENCAST CREATION SKILLS

- Identifying and using various icon-based composition tools
- Using contextual menus
- Navigating around the Prezi canvas
- Using Frames
- Using the Path Creation tool
- Creating and positioning screen visual elements: text, images, video
- Demonstrating how to implement the Prezi screencast production cycle
- Saving, naming, and sharing a Prezi screencast

CAPSTONE PROJECT

- Successfully build a basic Prezi screencast following in-class or online tutorials.
- Share access to the screencast by emailing its URL to a selected target audience.
